

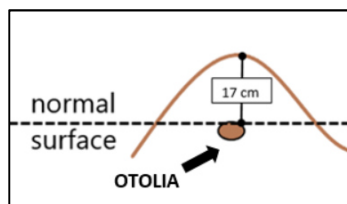
# OTOLIA

## GENERAL

- OTOLIA is a medium early variety (120 – 130 growing days)
- It's an easy growing variety
- Take the seed out of the bag directly after arrival for better seed conditions
- Soil preparation; aim should be a loose topsoil
- Planting distance:

- Planting depth: normal

- $P_2O_5$  90 kg/ha
- MgO 60 kg/ha
- No sensitivity against Metribuzin known

## ATTENTION POINTS

- Resistant intercrops for nematode control (oil radish) => biofumigation-effect (= incorporation of chaffed plants into the soil. By this isothiocyanates are generated, which fight soil-borne pests effectively)
- Seed dressing: treatment is recommended; preferably soil dressing (Azoxystrobin as a soil treatment shows good results against many fungi)
- Pre-sprouted or in germination stadium is recommended
- Planting in soils with a soil temperature > 8 °C
- heaped up the ridges not too high before emergence
- N 130-140 kg/ha incl.  $N_{min}$  as Ammonium or Amid (dependent from soil type/ location/ packing size)
- $K_2O$  280 - 300 kg/ha (as  $K_2SO_4$ ) – with irrigation split of the amounts 1/2:1/2
- OTOLIA is slightly sensitive to mechanical damages – harvest and handle with care
- Early lifting after skin set
